- 3: "I bind to myself to-day, The power of the love of Seraphim, In the obedience of Angels, (In the service of Archangels,) In the hope of Resurrection unto reward, In the prayers of the noble Fathers, In the predictions of the Prophets, In the preaching of Apostles, In the faith of Confessors, In purity of Holy Virgins, In the acts of Righteous Men."
- 4: "I bind to myself to-day, The power of Heaven, The light of the Sun, The brightness of the Moon, The force of Fire, The flashing of lightning, The velocity of Wind, The depth of the Sea, The stability of the Earth, The hardness of Rocks."
